Mobile Phone Policy

Continuing on from the new changing room policy, please make sure you read and understand the following information.

MOBILE PHONES WITH CAMERAS ARE NOT TO BE TAKEN INTO THE CHANGING ROOM AT ANY TIME.

Phones should be left with parents, team managers or put into lockers. This is the expectation of the EIHA from grassroots through to GB level. Any device used for providing music must not have a camera. Taking of photographs by officials inside a changing area is not permissible for any reason. The coach may carry a mobile phone for emergencies only.

Spot checks WILL be carried out regularly and the following will happen if you are caught breaking the rules....

1. The 1st time you are caught you will be given a verbal warning.
2. The 2nd time you are caught you will be asked to de-kit, get dressed and you WILL NOT be allowed to train.
3. The 3rd time you are caught, you will receive a 1 match ban.
4. The 4th and final time you are caught you risk being asked to leave the club permanently as per the player's code of conduct you all signed.
